ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR CLASS CERTIFICATION AND DISMISSING THE CASE

NOW THEREFORE, having come before the Court for hearing on June 13, 2023, upon Plaintiff JENNA COMPTON's Motion for Class Certification, and the Court having examined same, and otherwise being fully advised in the premises, it is thereupon:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED

The relevant facts in this case are not in dispute. Plaintiff's Sprint account fell delinquent and was referred to Defendant I.C. System, Inc., for collection purposes. Defendant thereafter sent collection letters to Plaintiff. Plaintiff filed this putative class action lawsuit alleging violations of the federal Fair Debt Collection Practices Act (FDCPA).

The Court finds Plaintiff has failed to demonstrate she suffered a pecuniary harm as a result of receiving Defendant's letters and judicial policy does not protect her interest in receiving truthful, non-misleading collection letters. *See, Friends of Black River Forest vs. Kohler Company*, 402 Wis.2d 587 (2022); *see also, Reetz v. Advocate Aurora Health, Inc.*, 983 N.W.2d 669 (Wis. Ct. App. 2022).

Because the Plaintiff lacks standing to pursue her individual claims against Defendant, the Court's only recourse is to dismiss the case.

Accordingly, Plaintiff's Motion for Class Certification is denied and this case is hereby dismissed.
